

Bushfire is not only a threat to those in the bush. If you live in an urban fringe or semi-rural area, **you need to be prepared.**

It is essential you ensure your property is prepared well in advance and **that you decide...**

“Am I **prepared** enough to **stay** and defend or will I **go** early?”



Your first decision will be “Will I Stay or Go Early?”

If your decision is to go early

your plan needs to include:

When you will leave? **Where** you will go? **How** you will get there? **What** you will take with you?
What you will do with your pets? **Who** you have told about your plan?

If your decision is to stay and defend your property

your plan needs to include:

Where you and other family members will be? **What** if your children are at school when the fire starts?
Who will look after your pets? **What** if you have elderly relatives or young children?
How you will protect your property? **How** you will protect yourself?
How you will know what is going on during the fire?

What you will do to patrol your property after the fire front has passed through?
